**RESOLUTION No. 001-2012

**RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING PCUP TO ENTER INTO A NEGOTIATED CONTRACT WITH EX-BATAAN
VETERANS SECURITY SERVICES INC. FOR THE PROVISION OF SECURITY
SERVICES AFTER TWO SUCCESSIVE FAILURES OF BID.**

WHEREAS, by virtue of S.O. Nos. 042-2012 and 086-2012, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) was created to enter into contract for Janitorial and Security Services;

WHEREAS, on 22 May 2012, the BAC announced the invitation to Bid for Security Service;

WHEREAS, only Ex-Bataan Veterans Security Services, Inc. submitted a proposal;

WHEREAS, on 30 October 2012, the BAC declared a Failure of Bidding and decided to extend the Invitation to Bid but still, no other agency submitted a proposal until the set deadline;

WHEREAS, on 12 November 2012, the pre-qualification documents of Ex-Bataan Veterans Security Services Inc., were evaluated and BAC requested the bidder to submit additional pertinent documents for the pre-qualifying requirements to which it complied;

WHEREAS, on 23 November 2012, BAC evaluated the pre-qualification documents of Ex-Bataan Veterans Services, Inc. and noted that Ex-Bataan Veterans Security Services Inc. had submitted all the required documents and was qualified to bid; and,

WHEREAS, on 19 December 2012, the BAC, after the process and procedures accepted and evaluated the Technical and Financial Proposal of Ex-Bataan Veterans Security Services Inc. and noted the following findings:

1. The offered Bid Price is Php1,367,430.00, for five Security Guards per year which is exactly the same with the approved PCUP Budget for Security Services.
2. The other services offered met the requirements of PCUP.

WHEREAS, in as much as the PCUP is also satisfied with the services of Ex-Bataan Veterans Services, Inc. having served the PCUP for the past several years;

NOW THEREFORE, it is resolved as it is hereby resolved that the BAC declares the Ex-Bataan Veterans Security Services Inc., as the sole bidder for the provision of security services, and the winning bid after passing all the BAC requirements.

RESOLVE FURTHER, that after two failures of bidding, the PBAC recommends to enter into a Negotiated Contract with Ex-Bataan Veterans Security Services Inc., for the provision of security services for three (3) years starting from February 1, 2013 to December 31, 2015, subject to an annual assessment of their work performance.
