

"A RESOLUTION CREATING THE TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP TO CONDUCT A STUDY, REVIEW AND RECOMMEND ASSESSMENT AND FINDINGS FOR THE PURPOSES OF RESIZING OF PERSONNEL AND JOB ORDER TO COMPLEMENT THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE 5-YEAR URBAN POOR ROAD MAP AND THE BANNER PROGRAM INCLUDING THE TRANSITION ON THE METRO URBAN CENTER IMPLEMENTATION AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREOF"

WHEREAS, the policy of State to promote and maintain effectiveness, efficiency and economy in the government and enhance institutional capacity to improve public service delivery, and to ensure the attainment of the country's societal and economic development goals and objectives;

WHEREAS, the government shall focus its functions and resources on the essential role, scope and level of governance, minimize, if not eliminate, redundancies, overlaps and duplication in its operations and simplify its rules and regulations, systems and processes;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Executive Order (EO) No. 82 dated December 8, 1986, it is the mandate of the Presidential Commission on the Urban Poor (PCUP) to serve as the direct link of the Urban Poor to the government in policy formulation and program implementation addressed to their needs;

WHEREAS, the role of government and the scope, level, and prioritization of government activities shall be determined in accordance with the Constitutional mandate, political and socio-economic objectives of the government, and available resources;

WHEREAS, the Vision of PCUP is to have a society where the poor are empowered, economically productive and actively participating in the poverty reduction program and sustainable development of the country;

WHEREAS, the Mission of the PCUP is to improved coordination and monitoring for the speedy implementation of government policies and programs for the urban poor and to enhanced accreditation of legitimate urban poor organizations for purposes of representation and policy formulation;

WHEREAS, in view of past experience and future needs, to reorganize and further strengthen the Office of the Chairperson as its principal arm in performing its constitutional duty under the provision of Executive Order No.82 as amended and strengthened by Executive Order No. 69, s. 2012;

WHEREAS, in the provision of Executive Order No. 1, s. 2016, the attainment of national development goals requires the efficient, responsive, and just allocation of resources by eliminating duplication or overlapping of common functions, maximizing research utilization with minimum disruption to operations, coordinating efforts more closely, sharing information, and consistently working in a collaborative manner;

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, We, the Commissioners and the Chairperson do hereby promulgate this resolution ***A RESOLUTION CREATING THE TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP TO CONDUCT A STUDY, REVIEW AND RECOMMEND ASSESSMENT AND FINDINGS FOR THE PURPOSES OF RESIZING OF PERSONNEL AND JOB ORDER TO COMPLEMENT THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE 5-YEAR URBAN POOR ROAD MAP AND THE BANNER PROGRAM INCLUDING THE TRANSITION ON THE METRO URBAN CENTER IMPLEMENTATION AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREOF***, to wit:

SECTION I: COVERAGE

This Resolution shall cover all Divisions, Units and Sections of the Presidential Commission for the Urban Poor.

SECTION II. GUIDELINES

The Presidential Commission for the Urban Poor shall promulgate the following implementing guidelines based on the proposed Senate Bill No. 1162, s. 2018:

- a. The delineation of responsibilities in the implementation of 5-year Development Plan, PRRD: NUPPCA and other frontline programs and services for the Urban Poor shall be clearly defined;
- b. Government operations shall be simplified so that the divisions, units and sections could focus of their core functions and implementations of programs and services that will lead to the attainment of the desired sectoral and national goals and outcomes;
- c. Government system s and processes shall be simplified to facilitate the delivery and upgrade the quality of frontline services, as well as to improve policy formulation, planning and performance evaluation;

- d. Government rules shall be rationalized to reduce the regulatory burden on citizens, businesses and other stakeholders; and
- e. The organizational structure of agencies shall be rightsized and the appropriate staffing mix shall be determined based on the skills and competencies required to effectively and efficiently carry out the agency mandate and functions

SECTION III. THE TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP (TWG) AND ITS COMPOSITION

There shall be a Technical Working Group or the Committee on Resizing of PCUP Personnel to be composed of the following:

SECTION IV: SECRETARIAT AND ITS FUNCTIONS

The Office of the Commissioner chaired of the Committee will act as its Secretariat and designated staff of the office will be appointed as the Head of the Secretariat.

1. It is primarily the responsibility of the Secretariat to provide linkages, support mechanism, monitoring and records keeping of the Climate Change Disaster Risk Resilient Project Technical Working Group.
2. The secretariat will be assisted by four (4) employees/staff of the Commission.
3. The Secretariat will submit reports to the members of the Commission.
4. Develop the policies, framework, strategies and mechanisms to be adopted in the implementation

SECTION V. COMPLETION

The TWG shall endeavor to complete its work on or before the lapse of six (6) months from the date it is convened. After its presentation to the Chairperson and CEO of its report, recommendations and proposal, the TWG shall wind up its operations.

Upon the Chairperson and CEO’s transmittal of the Commission on Secretary recommendations and proposals to the Cabinet Secretary.

SECTION VI: FUNDING AND OTHER ADMINISTRATIVE REQUIREMENTS

The funding and other administrative requirements of the Technical Working Group (TWG) will be incurred in the regular budget of the Commission.

SECTION VII. ADOPTION

Adopted during the Special Commission En Banc Session held in this 16th day of March our Lord 2018 at the Icon Hotel, Quezon City.
