COMMISSION RESOLUTION NO. 011

***"A RESOLUTION REVOKING PCUP Commission Resolution No. 001-2016 Effectively
DISSOLVING THE RELOCATION AND RESETTLEMENT MONITORING AND
DEVELOPMENT DIVISION"***

WHEREAS, the core mandate of PCUP pursuant to Executive Order No. 82 includes the monitoring of resettlement sites and resettled families and to undertake social preparation activities by virtue of Executive Order No. 69.

WHEREAS, the mandates of PCUP are well covered and served primarily by the : Research, Planning and Monitoring Division as well as the Field Operations Divisions (FOD-NCR, FOD-LUZON, FOD-VISAYAS, FOD-MINDANAO), even prior to the creation of the Relocation and Resettlement Monitoring and Development Division;

WHEREAS, the Relocation and Resettlement Monitoring Division was only created to transform the Project Management Office of the Informal Settler Families (PMO – ISF) Project into a Division and extend its life beyond the purpose of its creation;

WHEREAS, the Informal Settler Unit was only created as a Project Management Office for the focused implementation of the new-off site and in-city resettlement sites funded by the Php 50-Billion budget of the "Oplan Likas Programme" under the "Ten-Point Covenant" of President Aquino with the Urban Poor Sector;

WHEREAS, the stated reasons for the transformation of the Project Management Office of the Informal Settler Families (PMO – ISF) Project into a Division, are no longer applicable and relevant;

WHEREAS, the purposes for which the Relocation and Resettlement Monitoring Division was created, as well as its functions and current operations, already encroaches upon the functions that are primarily covered by the Research, Planning and Monitoring Division as well as the Field Operations Divisions (FOD-NCR, FOD-LUZON, FOD-VISAYAS, FOD-MINDANAO);

WHEREAS, the foregoing encroachments and overlapping of functions have rather become redundant, echoing the functions of other divisions and unnecessarily resulting in duplication of work further impeding our delivery of service;

WHEREAS, the Community Organizing and Community Development (CO-CD) Approach for the establishment of a sustainable resettlement program, together with the Research, Planning and Monitoring Division and the Field Operations Divisions primarily tasked over the same functions, and in coordination with the Supervising Commissioner on Resettlement shall sufficiently address matters of relocation, resettlement as well as its monitoring and development.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, the Commission En Banc **RESOLVED**, as it hereby Resolves the revocation of PCUP Commission Resolution No. 001-2016 effectively dissolving the Relocation and Resettlement Monitoring Division.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), Housing and Urban Development Coordinating Council (HUDCC), National Anti-Poverty Commission (NAPC), National Housing Authority (NHA), Social Housing Finance Corporation (SHFC), Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) and similar agencies for purposes of coordination, and to the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) for purposes of budgetary adjustments.
