**"A RESOLUTION CREATING PERSONS WITH DISABILITY AFFAIRS COMMITTEE (PDAC)
OF PRESIDENTIAL COMMISSION FOR THE URBAN POOR AND APPROPRIATING
FUNDS THEREOF"**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Republic Act No. 10070 an Act Establishing an Institutional Mechanism to ensure the Implementation of Programs and Services for Persons with Disabilities in every Province, City and Municipality, Amending Section 40 of Republic Act No. 7277, Otherwise known as the Magna Carta for Disabled Persons as Amended, and for Other Purposes, a Persons with Disability Affairs Office (PDAO) shall be organized and established in every province, city and municipality;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Executive Order (EO) No. 82 dated December 8, 1986, it is the mandate of the Presidential Commission on the Urban Poor (PCUP) to serve as the direct link of the Urban Poor to the government in policy formulation and program implementation addressed to their needs;

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, for and consideration of the foregoing, we, the Members of the Commission, by virtue of the powers vested on us by law, do hereby resolved the resolution entitled **A RESOLUTION CREATING PERSONS WITH DISABILITY AFFAIRS COMMITTEE (PDAC) OF PRESIDENTIAL COMMISSION FOR THE URBAN POOR AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREOF**, with the following provisions, to wit:

SECTION I: POLICY. It is a declared policy of Republic Act No. 7277 that persons with disabilities (PWDs) are part of the Philippine society, and thus the State shall give full support to the improvement of their total well-being and their integration into the mainstream of society. They have the same rights as other people to take their proper place in society;

SECTION II. OBJECTIVES. The main objectives of RA 10070 and by creating PDAC in PCUP is to ensure that policies, programs and services for persons with disabilities are implemented for them to fully participate in building an inclusive society for all.

SECTION III: COVERAGE. This resolution shall cover in Presidential Commission for the Urban Poor (PCUP) down to Field Operations Divisions.

SECTION IV: THE COMMITTEE AND ITS FUNCTIONS

- a. There shall be a committee of Persons with Disability Affairs Committee which is compose of the following:

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- b. The Committee may add members from time to time as circumstances may find it appropriate thru Committee Resolution.
- c. The Committee shall do the following functions in accordance with RA 7277 as amended by RA 10070, to wit:
- (1) Formulate and implement policies, plans and programs for the promotion of the welfare of urban poor persons with disabilities in coordination with concerned national and local government agencies.
 - (2) Submit reports to the office of the Office of the Chairperson and CEO on the implementation of programs and services for the promotion of the welfare of persons with disabilities in their respective areas of jurisdiction.
 - (3) Ensure that policies, plans and programs for the promotion of welfare of persons with disabilities are funded and implemented in accordance to the existing government accounting, budgeting and auditing rules and regulations.
 - (4) Shall coordinate with Persons with Disability Affairs Office in the local government unit for the capability program implementation.
 - (5) Perform such other functions as maybe necessary for the promotion and protection of the welfare of persons with disabilities.

SECTION V. SECRETARIAT. The office of Committee Chairperson (Commissioner) – Executive Assistant shall lead the Secretariat to be assisted the team identified by the PDAC.

SECTION VI: FUNDING AND OTHER ADMINISTRATIVE REQUIREMENTS. The funding and other administrative requirements of this resolution will be incurred 1% of the Gender and Development (GAD) Funds (5%).

SECTION VII. ADOPTION. Adopted and approved during the 4th Regular Commission En-Banc Meeting (RCM No. 4-2018) held on the 29th day of October 2018 at Hotel Rembrandt, Tomas Morato, Quezon City.
