COMMISSION RESOLUTION NO. 22
Series of 2018

**“A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE THREE (3) PRIORITY PROGRAMS
OF THE PRESIDENTIAL COMMISSION FOR THE URBAN POOR
FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2018-2022”**

WHEREAS, by virtue of Executive Order No. 82 dated 08 December 1986 and as strengthened by Executive Order No. 69 dated 29 March 2012, PCUP serves as a direct link of the urban poor to the government in policy formulation and program implementation addressed to their needs;

WHEREAS, one of the 10 Point Socio Economic Agenda of the Duterte Administration is to invest in human capital development, including health and education systems and match skills and training to meet the demand of business and the private sector;

WHEREAS, the Philippine Development Plan 2017-2022 stated that Filipino people primarily the urban poor wish to enjoy a “matatag, maginhawa at panatag na buhay” as well as maintain a comfortable life with affordable house and security of tenure including livelihood and employment opportunities which are all part of Ambisyon Natin 2040 development agenda;

WHEREAS, the Commission is persistently pursuing to implement the program priorities for 2018-2022 entitled *#PCUP on the Go* with three major components namely: the PCUP Caravan: Pinagsama-samang Serbisyo Para sa Tao, Adopt an Urban Poor Community Program and the PCUP Urban Poor Privilege Card;

WHEREAS, the PCUP Caravan aims to enhance awareness of the urban poor communities on the programs and services of the PCUP as well as of the entire government and to bring closer to the urban poor the basic services through a convergence approach in coordination with the different implementing agencies;

WHEREAS, Adopt an Urban Poor Community project intends to facilitate delivery of services to the urban poor communities by linking its concerns with the different sectors of society including the public and private sector such as top corporations and industries and identifying foundations with existing corporate social responsibility programs;


WHEREAS, the PCUP Urban Poor Privilege Card provides discounts on different basic services to assist the identified urban poor communities in accessing these various health, education, transportation, socio-economic and related assistance and benefits;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved, as it is hereby resolved, that the PCUP approves and supports the adoption and implementation of the Three (3) PCUP Priority Programs for the year 2018-2022.
